

Minutes of the Woodward County Commissioners Regular Meeting Tuesday, February 23, 2026 @ 10:00 a.m. at the Woodward County Board Meeting Room was called to order by Chairman Clint White with Vice-Chairman Donny Thorn & Member Troy White present. Also, present were Wendy Dunlap, Tom Lucas, Ben Smith, Keith Frutiger, Jared Garrett & Amanda Parks. Statement of Compliance acknowledged we have a quorum agenda was filed & posted February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026 @ 3:30 p.m. Motion was made by T. White to approve minutes from the previous meeting seconded by Thorn Voting: all ayes. Frutiger stated they were redoing their vest order & Garrett stated they are working on the access control system, Witchey stated the jail was written up on the wattage in the lamps C. White said he would contact the company. Lucas reported there are several funding opportunities are forthcoming through the USDOT Routes Initiatives Resources Program, Rural Development has announced the availability of Emergency Community Water Assistance Grants, Congressman's newsletter lists the resources & assistance programs, enrollment period for farmer bridge payments begins February 23<sup>rd</sup> & closes April 17<sup>th</sup> & the commissioners are eligible to submit a new application for \$5000 for the OCCEDB storm debris cleanup assistance program, the program administrator is requesting applications as soon as possible & there is a grant out there for \$30,000 for a chipper, C. White asked about the Industrial Road Grant Lucas will look into that grant. Motion was made by C. White to approve Temporary T-26-01 Declaration of a State of Emergency for Woodward County Wildlife Event 2-17-2026 this fire is 100% contained as of 7:30 a.m. this morning seconded by Thorn Voting: all ayes. C. White made a motion to approve Resolution R-26-16 Emergency Disaster Proclamation, now known as 43 Fire having occurred in the City of Woodward & Woodward County, Oklahoma causing considerable damage to public & private properties, seconded by T. White Voting: all ayes. Witchey reported she was ordering a headache rack for the pickup for her radio antenna height so she can reach out to everyone. A small video was played on Central Square Services for Fire & Sheriff's Departments followed by Smith's computer actual Central Square Services for City of Woodward showing where police & fire units are located in the city & county zooming in to trouble spots throughout the county Frutiger said it would be very helpful knowing where his units were so law enforcement & fire departments from out of town could be located where they are needed the most. C. White stated there may be a possible grant we will continue to look into Central Square Services. Motion was made by C.
