Statement of Compliance was acknowledged we have a quorum agenda was filed & posted March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026 @ 4:00 p.m. Motion was made by Thorn to approve minutes from the previous meeting seconded by T. Motion was made by Thorn to approve letter of support for Woodward County EMS as we submit applications to the OERSSIRF program -Request #1 Emergency Response Vehicle & Prehospital Blood Program, Request #2 Emergency Medical Dispatch Center Equipment & Power Load Cot, Request #3 Ambulance Replacement seconded by T. White Voting: all ayes. Motion was made by Thorn to approve Juvenile Detention Improvement Revolving Fund Application for Woodward County Juvenile Detention Center 85% is paid by OJA- \$13,260 for new fence total-\$15,6000 & 15% by Woodward County- \$2340 for removal & installation of new fence by Fence OKC seconded by T. White Voting: all ayes. Witchey reported that we will be in high fire danger midweek. As there was no other business before the board at this time a motion was made by T. White to adjourn seconded by Thorn Voting: all ayes.
