

Process mail and nursing home absentee ballots submitted for the April 7, 2026 Board of Education General election for Mooreland I-2 and Seiling I-8, Special Bond elections for Woodward I-1 and Fort Supply I-5, and City of Woodward City Commissioner race for Ward 2 including opening the outer envelopes and examining the affidavits for sufficiency, removing the affidavit envelopes, opening the secrecy envelope, and counting the ballots.
4. Canvass all absentee and precinct results for the April 7, 2026 Board of Education General Election returns for which Woodward County Election Board is the Parent County Election Board: Mooreland, I-2, Office No. 1.
5. Canvass all absentee and precinct results for the April 7, 2026 Board of Education General Election for the following school district for which the Woodward County Election Board is an affected County Election Board: Seiling, I-8, Office No. 1 to Dewey County Election Board.
6. Canvass all absentee and precinct results for the April 7, 2026 Special School Election Bond returns for the following district for which the Woodward County Election Board is the Parent County Election Board: Woodward, I-1.
7. Canvass all absentee and precinct results for the April 7, 2026 Special School Election Bond returns for the following district for which the Woodward County Election Board is the Parent County Election Board: Fort Supply, I-5.
8. Canvass all absentee and precinct results for the April 7, 2026 Woodward Municipal Election returns for the City of Woodward a home rule municipality totally contained within Woodward County, Ward 2 Commissioner's race.
